Senior Claire Brummeler has been named this week's Scottie of the Week for outstanding play against conference opponents Wesleyan College and Salem College. Brummeler posted 18 assists, one service ace and five digs in the team's 3-0 win over Wesleyan last Wednesday. On Friday, in a 3-0 win over Salem, Brummeler added two kills, 34 assists, three service aces and four digs. In the NCAA national rankings, Brummeler is currently tied for 26th for service aces per set with 26 aces in the last 32 sets for an average of 0.81 aces per set.
